

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICATION FOR VISITING STATUS
JURIS DOCTOR PROGRAM
2016**

A visiting applicant must submit the following:

1. Dated and signed Law School application. You may apply online through LSAC at www.lsac.org or mail in a printed or PDF version of the application. The PDF version may be found online at www.law.ua.edu/apply.
2. \$40.00 nonrefundable application fee. The fee may be paid online through LSAC or by check or money order directly to the Law School. Checks or money orders should be made payable to The University of Alabama. **Please do not send cash.**
3. Essay. Provide a statement explaining why you wish to visit at Alabama.
4. Résumé. Please attach a résumé that includes all full-time employment. Please also include honors, activities, and community and volunteer service.
5. Supplementary page providing details if you answer **Yes** to any portion of the **Code of Conduct section**. If you have questions about any part of the Code of Conduct section, please call the Law School Admissions Office. For the first question, do not include parking violations; speeding citations of 20 mph or less over the speed limit; or convictions or adjudications which have been sealed or expunged. However, you should be aware that state bar associations may require disclosure of all criminal matters and may consider these matters in bar admissions decisions. In addition to a bar examination, there are character, fitness, and other qualifications for admission to the bar in every U.S. jurisdiction. Applicants are encouraged to determine the requirements for any jurisdiction in which they intend to seek admission by contacting the jurisdiction. Addresses for all relevant agencies are available through the National Conference of Bar Examiners.
6. A letter of good standing from your law school stating that you have permission to visit at Alabama.
7. A Credential Assembly Service (CAS) file, which includes final transcripts from all undergraduate and graduate institutions.
8. One official law transcript.

Visitor Application Deadlines: July 22 for Fall Semester and December 11 for Spring Semester.
